



## Cambridge International Academy Scholarships

### Guidelines for Schools

#### 1. Introduction

The Cambridge International Academy Residential Summer School is a transformative experience that immerses students in the academic and social life of Cambridge. We are excited to offer scholarships to students from disadvantaged backgrounds who have demonstrated strong academic results which aims to provide them with an opportunity to participate in our academically focused summer school.

We are offering a maximum total of 40 scholarship places in 2024, with a mixture of fully and partially funded awards for both UK and international students. In the UK and in Canada, we are partnering with schools to help publicise and administer the scholarship programme.

#### 2. School Responsibilities

We request schools publicise these opportunities, and encourage students they believe would benefit the most from this opportunity to apply. The selection process will be conducted by Cambridge International Academy, and we will notify schools of the results in a timely manner.

A full-time teacher at the school with knowledge of the applicant, will be asked to confirm that the applicant satisfies the eligibility criteria i), ii) and iv) below and that the application is bona fide.

#### 3. Reminder of eligibility criteria

1. Be a UK citizen or have the right to reside in the UK and study at a UK state school,
2. Come from a disadvantaged background: a) be the first in their family to be applying to university, have been eligible to qualify for free school meals in the last five years, or both; b) demonstrate the financial need to qualify for the scholarship (i.e. unable to attend without the support of a scholarship),
3. Be currently enrolled in a school that partners with Cambridge International Academy,
4. Meet the entrance requirements for their course
5. Be available to attend the whole duration of the residential summer school in Cambridge, UK.
